



Locker Rooms

Monitoring

Club staff regularly monitor youth locker rooms during club operations. Staff are stationed outside of the locker room, monitoring entry and exit. Additionally, space is inspected between use to assure that misuse or issues have not presented. Staff are not to be present in locker room when youth are actively using facility, except for a medical emergency in which youth attention is needed.

Cleanliness, Maintenance, Hazard Prevention

Locker rooms are inspected, at minimum, 4 times per day to complete cleaning, note any repairs needing immediate attention, and that there are no material, slipping, tripping or injury hazards. A check-off form is hung in the locker room indicating the at the inspection occurred.

Operation

- Staff will sign Members in before they enter the Locker Rooms
- Staff must always maintain at least four people in the Locker Room (with 1 of the 4 being staff) and wait together until all members are finished and ready to enter the pool; if two members need to change, Staff will wait out front and send them into the locker room one at a time (to follow the 3 + Me rule)
- Members will be directed to open changing stalls when accompanied by Staff
- Staff will upkeep and follow all Locker Room rules

Rules

- Members will wait in locker area (behind white line) while waiting for an open stall
- One member at a time per changing stall
- No changing outside of stalls
- No cellphones or electronics in use at all in the locker rooms– all electronics must be kept inside personal bags
- No looking under or over stalls
- No passing items to other Members in stalls
- No screaming or yelling
- No touching other Members at all
- No helping other Members with hair (including staff doing members hair for them)
- Each Member must have their own swimsuit and towel before entering the pool
- Members must speak to each other and Staff politely – no arguing, or rude behaviors
- Members must have on clothes or appropriate swimming attire before exiting their stalls
- Members must change out of wet swim attire and into dry clothes before leaving the Locker Room after swimming
